

Tusayan Town Council to Call For Election
For Referendums and an Ethics Initiative
Arguments “For” & “Against” Accepted Through January 27

Tusayan, Az. — At their Regular meeting on Wednesday, January 4, 2012, Tusayan Town Council voted to call for an election for the community of Tusayan to consider five Referendums and an Initiative. The election is scheduled for the May 15 2012 ballot.

The election will be conducted as a polling place election. The polling location will be the Grand Hotel.

As part of the process, arguments “for” and “against” the ballot question are being requested by the Town for inclusion in the informational pamphlet. Any interested citizen or group may submit an argument. This pamphlet will be mailed to all registered households within the proposed boundaries.

Each argument must be **300** words or less and may be typed or handwritten. The argument must include the author’s name, original signature, address and telephone number (address and phone number will not appear in the mailed informational pamphlet). A fee of \$100 for paper submissions or \$75 for a submission in a CD format is due and payable at the time of filing. A printed copy of the argument must be filed with the CD to comply with the **original** signature(s) requirement.

Arguments must be received by **5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 27, 2011** at the Town of Tusayan office at the Grand Canyon Airport. The mailing address is P.O. Box 709, Grand Canyon, AZ; 86023. The physical address is 3568 Airport Road, Tusayan, Arizona.
